All entry forms to be completed and handed to the Secretary of the section, **Dr Susan Loxdale, Castle Hill, Llanilar, Aberystwyth, SY23 4SB** email: **susanloxdale23@gmail.com** mobile **07971 651909** with the entry fee of 50p per exhibit on or before **Thursday 9th August 2018**, or can be left with correct entry fee in a sealed envelope at Llanilar or Llanfarian Shop. **NO LATE ENTRIES OR ENTRIES ON SHOW DAY WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Entry forms should clearly state whether member of **YFC, Llanilar WI, Merched Y Wawr Bro llar or Members of Llanilar Senior Citizens Club.** Garden competition entries to be in by 22nd July 2018 and judging will take place for gardens in late July - early August.
2. Exhibitors are not allowed more than two entries in each class.
3. Only exhibitors are allowed within the Marquee when entries are being set up.
4. Exhibits should be staged between 8am - 10.15am. Judging will begin at 10.30am prompt.
5. Exhibitors must place under each exhibit a card with his/her name and address.
All cards will be supplied by stewards. No other cards will be permitted.
6. Exhibits must not be removed before the end of the presentation of prizes.
7. Prize money must be collected on day of Show – any prize money left over will be taken as a donation to Show funds.
8. While the stewards will do their best to supervise, no responsibility is taken for loss or damage to exhibits.
9. Flowers are to be exhibited in vases, except where otherwise specified.
10. All exhibits must be the property of and grown by the exhibitor.

250g/9oz Self Raising Flour
1/4 level tsp salt
125g/4oz Butter
75g/3oz Desiccated Coconut
125g/4oz Caster Sugar
125g/4oz Glace Cherries
2 Eggs Beaten
225ml/8fl oz Milk
Desiccated Coconut for decoration

METHOD: Grease and base line a loaf tin
Combine flour and salt and rub in the butter, stir in the coconut, sugar and Cherries.
Whisk together the eggs and milk and beat in to the other ingredients.
Spoon mix into prepared tin level the top and decorate with coconut such as desiccated coconut.
Bake in the oven at 180C/350F Gas Mark 4 for approx. 1 ½ hours. Cover with foil after 40 minutes.
