Diolch i'r casglwyr, stiwardiaid a'r beirniaid am eich parodrwydd i gefnogi'r sioe.



SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

The Llanilar and North Cardiganshire Agricultural & Horticultural Society is committed to the minimum standards as laid down in the Health & Safety at Work etc Act 1974, and wherever possible higher standards will be maintained to ensure the overall safety of all those involved in organising and visiting the Llanilar and North Cardiganshire Agricultural & Horticultural Show.

The Society will review its policy statement annually as required by the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974.

POLICY STATEMENT

Llanilar and North Cardiganshire Agricultural & Horticultural Society accepts its responsibility for providing and maintaining so far as is reasonably practicable, at all times during the setting up and running of Llanilar Show, an environment which is both safe and healthy for all.

To this end Llanilar and North Cardiganshire Agricultural & Horticultural Society will take all steps within its powers to meet its responsibilities under the Health & Safety Act 1974 and all other legal requirements for Health and Safety, and actively seeks the full and understanding co-operation of all persons involved in the Show for their commitment to the same.

All exhibitors must take reasonable care for the Health and Safety of themselves and any other person who may be affected by their acts or omissions. It is a condition of entry that all horse and livestock exhibitors have adequate public liability insurance in place for their activities at Llanilar Show.

No exhibitor will be accepted without adequate public liability insurance

Policy Arrangements

Llanilar Show's General Safety Policy is as follows:

To conduct the Show's undertaking in such a way as to ensure so far as reasonably practicable, that persons who may be affected by its activities are not exposed to risks to their Health and Safety.

To bring to the notice of all Exhibitors, Retailers, Caterers and their Agents and Employees their duty to co-operate with the Show to ensure that this policy is effective and to offer all necessary assistance to ensure the Health and Safety at the Show of all Exhibitors and others on the show field.

It is incumbent upon those participating or attending the Show before, during and after the Show to prevent accidents and incidents and to assist the Show in their aims by preventing accidents and incidents and abiding by the instructions given by the officials and stewards of the Show.

To achieve these aims, suitable and sufficient risk assessments will be carried out and reviewed on the morning of the Show, the risk assessment will include for individual exhibitors and the Show's activities.

Emergency Procedure

These instructions should be adhered to in the event of a major incident occurring on the show field during the Show period.

- I The Safety Officer (Mr Wyn Evans) should be contacted immediately by public address or mobile telephone (07817 592411)
- 2 The Major Incident control point will be the Secretary's Tent.
- 3 First Aid personnel will be located on the show field, normally positioned near the Secretary's tent, but will be contacted immediately by public address or mobile telephone.
- 4 Gate stewards will assist Emergency vehicles to the scene of the accident.
- 5 Casualty Centre has been identified as the Secretary's Tent.
- 6 Should total evacuation of the showground be required the Safety Officer will enlist the help of all stewards to ensure that this is done in an orderly fashion via the Falcon Entrance.

Reporting of Injuries and Dangerous Occurrences (RIDDOR)

Any accidents or incidents must be reported to the Show's Safety Officer immediately. The Safety Officer will investigate all incidents and liaise with the appropriate enforcing authority and Show officials. All accidents will be recorded in the Show's accident book.

Responsibilities for Health and Safety

The Show has overall responsibility for all aspects of Health and Safety and shall require everybody under its control to be familiar with the regulations, codes of practice and the Show's procedure for ensuring the safe working conditions on the Show premises.

Safety Officer (along with other officials of the Show)

Responsibilities will include the following:

- 1 Provide guidance and advice on health and safety matters
- 2 Liaising with all statutory and external authorities and other appropriate organisations
- 3 Investigating and recording all accidents and incidents
- 4 Briefing and training all officials and stewards on the emergency procedure prior to Show day.

Organisers, Trade stand Officer and Contractors

Organisers, Trade Stand Officer and Contractors and their respective employees as well as Estate Owners and their Agents are responsible for ensuring that:

- 1 Everything reasonably practicable is done to ensure the Health and Safety and Welfare of those attending the Show.
- 2 They conduct themselves, so that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk.
- 3 The access to, and egress from the show field is safe and unobstructed, Members of the Public and Competitors are equally responsible for ensuring that they do not put other persons at risk and that they co-operate with the organisers in compliance with Health and Safety legislation.

Health and Safety Arrangements

- 1 Electricity. The position and routes of overhead, underground and temporary electrical cables and distribution systems will be agreed, evidence of recent examination and test certificates for electrical instillations and apparatus will be obtained for the show field installations and from individual exhibitors; earthing and earth leakage protection will be provided as necessary. All Generators should be used with a circuit breaker at all times.
- 2 **Generators** must be positioned well clear of tentage and any other flammable materials
- 3 **Liquid Petroleum Gas.** Trade stand personnel and caterers with LPG appliances should have these examined and tested by a competent person.
- 4 **Machinery** should only be used by competent people, loaned equipment should be fully serviceable. Plant and machinery should only be operated after adequate safety precautions have taken. Chainsaw operators should be correctly clothes and equipped. Chains should be of adequate strength and attached to the towing tractor below the axle.
- Animals. Routes used by Horses, Public and Vehicles will, as far as possible, be kept separate.
 Horses are not allowed into the Trade Stand and Catering areas. Dogs should be kept on a lead at all times and all dog excrement should be disposed of in a suitable manner.
 - **Children** must be supervised by an adult.
- 6 **Safety Information**. Warning notices and signs are prominently displayed.
- 7 Toilet and Washing Facilities. Adequate provision has been made for the expected number of visitors.
- 8 **Food Hygiene**. Caterers are responsible for complying with Local Authority Environmental Health Department Legislation/ Food Safety Act.
- 9 **Licensing** for Alcohol Refreshments. Licences are held for alcohol sale.

If any person attending the Show fails to comply with the reasonable requirements relating to Health and Safety at the Show, then the Show committee will have the right to eject that person from the Show. If the Show committee fail to take adequate action where a breach comes to notice, then they could potentially find themselves, albeit unwillingly, in the position of condoning a breach of the regulations.

All persons attending the Show whether they be officials, competitors or members of the public must comply with the Health and Safety Regulations.

RHEOLAU AC AMODAU - RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. That the Society be called "The Llanilar and North Cardiganshire Agricultural Society", holding its Show at Llanilar and that the Show be open to all-comers.
- 2. That the Society shall consist of a President, Treasurer, Managers, Secretary and Members.
- 3. That all Subscribers of £5 and upwards receive an admission ticket.
- 4. That all Subscriptions for Membership be paid for the year no later than August in each year.
- 5. All entries to be sent to the Organising Secretary on or before the closing date as stated on the entry form.
- 6. That all exhibits must be on the Showground in advance of appropriate class please see timetable.
- 7. All Horse and Livestock competitors to call for their numbers at the Secretary's Tent on the morning of the Show. NOTE: Field Prizes must be collected from the TREASURER'S CARAVAN on presentation of a ROSETTE on the day of the Show. Tent Prizes must also be collected on the day of the Show, otherwise prize money will be forfeited.
- 8. Any objection must be sent in writing to the Secretary within Seven Days of the date of the Show together with a deposit of £5, which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
- 9. That the judges be directed to withhold any prize if they consider there is not sufficient merit or that the Exhibitor is not properly classed.
- 10. That one person in charge of each exhibit must attend to the same and obey the instructions of the Stewards and Secretary, or otherwise be subject to expulsion and disqualification.
- 11. Exhibitors' numbers will be issued on the showground.
- 12. The person attending to stock on behalf of the exhibitor must be acquainted with all particulars required to be certified regarding the stock in his charge.
- 13. That all exhibits must have been in the possession of the Exhibitor for at least three months before the date of the Show. The Committee will not be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury that may happen to any exhibit. No expense or risk will be incurred by the Society either in the reception or return of stock.
- 14. Any exhibitor obtaining a prize fraudulently will forfeit the prize he may otherwise be entitled to, and shall be prohibited from exhibiting in future.
- 15. That each exhibit must be fully described on the Entry Form and each Form must be filled and signed by the Exhibitor or his Agent and accompanied by the Entrance Fee or less otherwise the entry will not be valid.
- 16. That no person be allowed in the Ring except the Stewards and Judges of the Class then being judged and the person in charge of the exhibits.
- 17. Should the total receipts be less than the expenditure, the committee shall have power to deduct a proportionate percentage from all money prizes offered in the Schedule (whether Ordinary or Special) sufficient to make up the deficiency.
- 18. Should any question arise, either upon the foregoing Rules and Regulations, or any other matter connected with the Show, the same shall be referred to the Officials of the Committee, whose decision shall be final.
- 19. The Committee reserve to themselves the right to refuse any entry or cancel any entry made.
- 20. The financial year shall be from 1st January to 31st December and the Annual General Meeting shall be held in January.
- 21. All horses shown in hand are to be led and driven with reins.
- 22. Trotting horses or Horse and Trap around the Showground is strictly prohibited.
- 23. Challenge prizes must be won three times in succession or five times in all before becoming the property of the winner.
- 24. All cups must be signed for before leaving the field, to include dog show trophy recipients.
- 25. Local Class in Agricultural Section will be confined to the Aberystwyth Rural Districts, South of Rheidol and the Parishes of Lledrod Upper and Lower with Gwnnws Upper and Lower. All stock entered in the Herd and stock competitions must be grazed and judged within the local boundary (see Map defining local area).
- 26. The Committee reserve the right to inspect the exhibitor's gardens.
- Maedi Visna All stock entered in the accredited section must be accompanied by a SAC Valid Certificate of Status.
- 28. Trade Stalls entries closing date 1st August 2023.
- 29. Children's Show-jumping Classes Exhibits must be supervised by parent or an adult at all times.
- 30. Professional photographing or filming is forbidden without prior permission of the Committee.
- 31. It is advised that back protectors are worn by all riders at all times when jumping.
- 32. All sheep exhibitors to bring 2 movement licences with them on the day of the Show.
- 33. Exhibitors warming up for ridden classes should do so ONLY in the designated warm-up areas.
- 34. The judge's decision is final.

Special Rules & Regulations Applying To All Horse Entries

Any person riding a horse anywhere on the showground is required to:

- 1. Wear a hard hat of a standard approved by their appropriate governing body and ensure that the chin strap is fastened. It is also recommended that children leading a horse/pony wear a hard hat too.
- 2. Remain in the horse section, horse walks and judging areas only. No horse is to be ridden or led through any other areas of the showground.
- 3. Stallions/colts may not be led nor ridden by a junior who has not attained their 12th birthday by the 1st of January in the current year.
- 4. The onus is on every rider who suffers a fall or anybody who suffers an injury whilst on the show field, to report the fall/injury to the secretary in the Secretaries' Tent.
- 5. No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, leesee, authorized agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at any risk of injury. Those entering on the Show day should inform the steward if their exhibit is a stallion.
- 6. No mounted rider should canter outside of a ring or practice ring nor exceed the recommended number in a practice ring [max capacity will be stated outside the ring].






Chocolate and Orange Marble Cake

225g very soft butter, plus extra for greasing
225g caster sugar
225g self-raising flour
4 large eggs, beaten
25g orange chocolate, broken into pieces
25g orange chocolate, broken into pieces

Method

- 1. Heat oven to 180C/fan 160C/gas 4. Grease and line the base of a 2 lb loaf tin (roughly 21cm x 11cm and 7cm deep) with baking parchment. Beat the butter, sugar, eggs and flour together in a large bowl with an electric whisk or in a food processor until lump free.
- 2. Split the mixture into two bowls, beat the milk, followed by the cocoa powder into one. Beat the orange juice, zest and orange food colouring, if using, into the other.
- 3. Spoon alternate dollops of the mixture into the cake tin, then use a skewer to create a marble pattern by dragging it through the mixture in swirls. Make sure you don't over mix or you won't see the pattern. Smooth the surface if necessary.
- 4. Bake the cake for 45 55 mins until golden and risen, and a skewer poked in comes out clean.
- 5. Leave the cake in the tin to cool, then turn out. Melt the chocolate in a bowl over barely simmering water or gently in the microwave. Use a spoon to drizzle the chocolate over the cake.




